NOTICE OF NOMINATION AND ELECTION OF SKILLED TRADES BARGAINING TEAM MEMBERS

Notice is hereby given of the nomination and election for the following bargaining team members to negotiate a successor agreement for:

California State University (Unit 6) 6 members

Bargaining Team Composition: In accordance with Article 7 of the collective bargaining agreement with the California State University, the Union will comprising a bargaining team that includes six (6) rank-and-file members. Bargaining team seats will be assigned by region in an effort to equitably represent members across the State. A candidate's "home" campus will determine the seat they are running for. The seats and their geographic representation will be as follows:

North – Seat 1

CSU Humboldt, CSU Chico, CSU Sonoma, CSU Sacramento

South - Seat 1

CSU Northridge, CSU Long Beach

North – Seat 2

CSU San Francisco, CSU San Jose, CSU East Bay, CSU Monterey Bay

South – Seat 2

CSU Chancellor's Office, CSU Los Angeles, CSU Dominguez Hills, CSU Pomona, CSU San Bernardino

North – Seat 3

CSU Stanislaus, CSU Fresno, CSU Bakersfield, CSU San Luis Obispo, CSU Channel Islands

South – Seat 3

CSU Fullerton, CSU San Marcos, CSU San Diego

Nominations: Nominations will be accepted beginning February 5, 2019, through February 12, 2019. Nominations should be submitted to Skilled Trades Division liaison Carlos Diaz at cdiaz@teamsters2010.org; or mailed or faxed to his attention at Teamsters Local 2010, 9900 Flower Street, Bellflower, CA 90706; fax (562) 376-1709. Nominations must be received no later than 5:00 PM on Tuesday, February 12, 2019. Nominations must be made by a member in good standing other than the nominee, seconded by a member in good standing other than the nominee, and accepted by the nominee. Prospective nominees are encouraged to verify the good standing status of their nominator and seconder as part of the nominations process by submitting a written request to the Secretary-Treasurer, Teamsters Local 2010, 400 Roland Way, Suite 2010, Oakland, California 94621. Every trades division member of Local 2010 whose dues are paid up through January 2019, shall have the right to nominate and second or otherwise support the candidate of their choice. Any back dues or fees may be paid at the Local Union office through 4:00 p.m. on February 11, 2019. No member whose dues have been withheld by the employer for payment to the Local Union pursuant to his or her voluntary authorization provided for in a collective bargaining agreement shall be declared ineligible to nominate

or second a candidate for office in the Local Union, by reason of the Employer's delay or default in the payment of dues to the Local Union. Nominees who accept must read and sign the bargaining committee job description and pledge.

Election: All members in good standing by the payment of dues through the month of January 2019, shall be eligible to run for office provided they are actively employed and have been properly nominated. Potential candidates are encouraged to check their eligibility prior to the voting period by submitting a written request to the Secretary-Treasurer, Teamsters Local 2010, 400 Roland Way, Suite 2010, Oakland, California 94621. The election will be conducted in-person by paper ballot at campus meetings February 14-22, 2019. A list of meeting dates and times can be found at www.teamsters2010.org. Ballots cast at location meetings will be counted and witnessed at the end of each meeting with the results tallied, emailed and posted on February 25, 2019.
