



Teamsters Local 2010 Procedure for Distribution of Candidate Literature

Each candidate shall be permitted a reasonable opportunity, equal to that of any other candidate, to have his/her literature distributed at the candidates' expense. This means: (a) each candidate is entitled to request a mailing(s), whether or not any other candidate makes such request(s); (b) similar distribution and the same conditions and costs shall be made for all candidates; and (c) the distribution of any candidate's literature will not be made if that candidate is not able and willing to pay the costs for such distribution. The mailing and distribution of any candidate literature shall be governed by this Local Union policy. Any request for distribution of literature shall be made by the candidate directly to:

The request shall specify the portion of the membership that is to receive the mailing and an instruction as to the class or type of mailing or postage desired. The request shall be accompanied by at least one (1) copy of the literature (if the candidate wishes it to be duplicated by the mailing house) or by a number of copies sufficient for distribution (if the candidate duplicates the literature him/herself), or by a number of sealed envelopes, containing the literature, sufficient for distribution (if the candidate duplicates the literature and stuffs the envelopes him/herself). It is VERY IMPORTANT to first check with the mailing house regarding any mailing you wish to do in order to make sure that you understand the process and the costs associated with a mailing. Each candidate shall pay directly to the mail house for the actual cost of distribution, including stationary, duplication, time required to do the work and postage for mailing.
