RE: **BALLOT RE-MAILING NOTICE**

Dear Candidates:

Please be advised that UniLect Election Services will be picking up all un-deliverable ballot packets on a daily basis beginning on March 2, 2021 through March 26, 2021. As a Candidate running for Delegate, you have the right to be present, or have an observer present on your behalf, to observe the pick-up of un-deliverables and the re-mailing of ballots when updated addresses are received or duplicate ballots requests are fulfilled.

The re-mailing of ballots will begin on March 3, 2021 and continue through March 26, 2021 by a UniLect representative. There may be some days when there are no new ballots to be re-mailed, so if you would like to observe this process, please call Catherine Burkhart at (925) 209-9317 (cell) to confirm when the next re-mailing is to take place.

If the United States Post Office has provided a new address on the un-deliverable, UniLect will process and re-mail the ballot packet immediately after documenting. In the event the un-deliverable contains no forwarding information from the USPS, UniLect will provide the Local Union Titan Operator with a list of bad address returns and Local Staff will do their best to obtain a better address for that member. Updated addresses provided to UniLect will be re-mailed on same business day or next business day.

All Duplicate Ballot Requests will be mailed from this USPS address as well. Members requesting a Duplicate Ballot must make the request personally (not via another member) by calling 855-240-0363. This toll-free Call Center is available 24/7 with English and Spanish speaking operators standing by. IMPORTANT: UniLect cannot control USPS delivery schedules. All ballots will be mailed using 1st Class postage. If a member has spoiled their ballot or has not received a ballot by March 8, 2021, they should contact UniLect's Duplicate Request Call Center right away. The sooner a member calls the better the chance a member has to receive a replacement ballot and mail it back in time to be counted.

Ballots must be received at the Post Box address on the Return Envelope by 11:00 a.m. on Monday, March 29, 2021, for it to be counted. Further details will be included in the Official Ballot Packet.
